1 INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2017-086 2 REQUESTING THAT THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES AND 3 4 GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS STUDY THE PROCESS FOR AWARDING HOMESTEAD 5 PROPERTY TAX CREDITS, INCLUDING THE MECHANISMS IN PLACE TO 6 GUARANTEE THAT A CITIZEN OWNING MULTIPLE PARCELS OF LAND RECEIVE 7 ONLY ONE (1) TAX CREDIT. 8 WHEREAS, Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 79, § 3, requires that the 9 10 General Assembly provide by law for an annual state credit against ad valorem 11 property tax on a homestead; and 12 WHEREAS, Arkansas Code § 26-26-1118 implements Amendment 79, § 3, by 13 14 establishing a homestead property tax credit for each assessment year that 15 reduces the amount of real property taxes assessed on the homestead of each 16 property owner by three hundred fifty dollars (\$350); and 17 WHEREAS, while many citizens of Arkansas own multiple parcels of land, 18 19 each individual may claim only one (1) homestead property tax credit; and 20 21 WHEREAS, past media reports have evidenced that some citizens of the 22 state owning multiple parcels of land receive more than one (1) homestead 23 property tax credit, particularly if the parcels of land are in different 24 counties; and 25 26 WHEREAS, while roughly seven hundred thousand (700,000) parcels of land 27 in this state are identified with a homestead property tax credit, there is 28 no way to determine whether that number includes multiple homestead property 29 tax credits for the same citizen; and 30 31 WHEREAS, the state should consider methods to ensure that citizens of 32 the state claim only one (1) homestead property tax credit as envisioned by Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 79, § 3, 33 34 35 NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT PROPOSED BY THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES AND GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: THAT the Senate Committee on State Agencies and Governmental Affairs study methods to ensure that citizens of the state claim only one (1) homestead property tax credit, including without limitation studying: (1) The total number and dollar value of homestead property tax credits extended to citizens of the State of Arkansas; (2) The process for claiming homestead property tax credits; (3) Reimbursement provided to counties to offset the award of homestead property tax credits; (4) Existing mechanisms to ensure that citizens do not claim more than one (1) homestead property tax credit; and (5) Possible additional mechanisms to ensure that citizens do not claim more than one (1) homestead property tax credit, including without limitation the cost and feasibility of these additional mechanisms. BE IT FURTHER PROPOSED that the House Committee on State Agencies and Governmental Affairs be invited to meet jointly with the Senate Committee on State Agencies and Governmental Affairs and participate in the study.
