10	A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION
11	REQUIRING THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO PROVIDE BY LAW THAT
12	THE REVENUES DERIVED FROM TAXES ON THE SALE OF TIRES,
13	CAR BATTERIES, AND OTHER ITEMS FOR INSTALLATION IN OR
14	UPON A MOTOR VEHICLE SHALL BE ALLOCATED TO THE STATE
15	HIGHWAY COMMISSION AND THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF
16	TRANSPORTATION OR ITS SUCCESSOR AGENCIES TO BE USED
17	FOR CONSTRUCTION AND IMPROVEMENTS OF HIGHWAYS AND
18	ROADS WITHIN THE STATE.

22	A PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO
23	PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN TAX REVENUES SHALL
24	BE ALLOCATED TO THE STATE HIGHWAY
25	COMMISSION AND THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF
26	TRANSPORTATION FOR HIGHWAY AND ROAD
27	CONSTRUCTION AND IMPROVEMENTS.

30	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
31	STATE OF ARKANSAS, AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL
32	MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:
33	
34	That the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
35	the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
36	for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives

1	and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
2	adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
3	the State of Arkansas, to wit:
4	
5	SECTION 1. The Arkansas Constitution is amended to read as follows:
6	§ 1. Allocation of certain tax revenue to State Highway Commission and
7	Arkansas Department of Transportation.
8	(a) The General Assembly shall provide by law that the revenues
9	derived from taxes on the sale of tires, car batteries, and other items for
10	installation in or upon a motor vehicle shall be allocated to the State
11	Highway Commission and the Arkansas Department of Transportation or its
12	successor agencies to be used for construction and improvements of highways
13	and roads within the state.
14	(b) The General Assembly may enact laws to implement this amendment,
15	including without limitation laws specifying the taxable items for which
16	revenues shall be allocated to the State Highway Commission and the Arkansas
17	Department of Transportation or its successor agencies.
18	
19	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This amendment is effective on and after
20	January 1, 2021.
21	
22	SECTION 3. BALLOT TITLE AND POPULAR NAME. <u>When this proposed</u>
23	amendment is submitted to the electors of the state on the general election
24	<u>ballot:</u>
25	(1) The title of this joint resolution shall be the ballot
26	title; and
27	(2) The popular name shall be "A Proposed Constitutional
28	Amendment to Provide that Revenues Derived from Taxes on the Sale of Items
29	for Installation in or Upon a Motor Vehicle Shall be Used for Construction
30	and Improvements of Highways and Roads Within the State".
