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1 (B) The healthcare professional personally knows the 2 patient and the patient's relevant health status through an ongoing personal or professional relationship and is available to provide appropriate follow-3 4 up care, when necessary, at medically necessary intervals; 5 (C) The treatment is provided by a healthcare professional 6 in consultation with, or upon referral by, another healthcare professional 7 who has an ongoing relationship with the patient and who has agreed to 8 supervise the patient's treatment, including follow-up care; 9 (D) An on-call or cross-coverage arrangement exists with 10 the patient's regular treating healthcare professional or another healthcare professional who has established a professional relationship with the 11 12 patient; 13 (E) A relationship exists in other circumstances as 14 defined by rule of the Arkansas State Medical Board for healthcare 15 professionals under its jurisdiction and their patients; or 16 (F) A relationship exists in other circumstances as 17 defined by rule of a licensing or certification board for other healthcare 18 professionals under the jurisdiction of the appropriate board and their 19 patients if the rules are no less restrictive than the rules of the Arkansas 20 State Medical Board; or 21 (G) A relationship exists through the use of telemedicine 22 <u>if:</u> 23 (i) In the opinion of the healthcare professional, 24 the standard of care can be met; and 25 (ii) The healthcare professional has access to the 26 patient's medical history; 27 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-80-403(c), concerning the establishment 28 29 of a professional relationship, is amended to read as follows: 30 (c) "Professional relationship" does not include a relationship 31 between a healthcare professional and a patient established only by the 32 following: 33 (1) An internet questionnaire; 34 (2) An email message; 35 (3) Patient-generated medical history;

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     interactive audio without a patient medical history;
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                 (5)(4) Text messaging;
                 (6) (5) A facsimile machine; or
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                 (7)(6) Any combination thereof.

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     healthcare professional shall amend their its rules where necessary to comply
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    with this subchapter.
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           (b) However, a state licensing and certification board for a
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     healthcare professional shall not implement rules that are more restrictive
    than this subchapter.
