21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-89-102(4), concerning the definition of		
24 25	"ophthalmic dispensing", is amended to read as follows:		
26	(4)(A) "Ophthalmic dispensing" means the preparation of laboratory work orders, verification, and dispensing of spectacle lenses,

28	spectacles, eyeglasses, or parts thereof <u>, or contact lenses</u> to the intended wearer on a written prescription from a licensed physician skilled in disease		
20	of the eye or from a licensed optometrist.		
30	(B) " Opthalmic <u>Ophthalmic</u> dispensing" shall include

32	(i) The measuring, fitting, adapting, and adjusting

1 (iii) The verification of the quality of finished 2 spectacle lenses, spectacles, or eyeglasses; and (iv) The adjustment or repair of spectacle frames to 3 4 the human face; and 5 (v) The adapting, fitting, duplicating, dispensing, 6 modifying, selling, or supplying of contact lenses for the human eye. 7 (C) The prescribing, adapting, fitting, duplicating, 8 dispensing, modifying, selling, or supplying of contact lenses for or to the 9 human eye is specifically excluded; 10 11 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-89-104(d), concerning the prohibition of 12 the practice of optometry or medicine by licensed dispensing opticians, is 13 amended to read as follows: 14 (d) The prescribing, adapting, fitting, duplicating, dispensing, modifying, selling, or supplying of contact lenses for or to the human eye is 15 16 specifically prohibited except when done by a licensed optometrist or 17 licensed physician skilled in disease of the eye. 18 19 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 89, Subchapter 4, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows: 20 21 17-89-409. Contact lenses. 22 (a) The Arkansas Board of Dispensing Opticians shall adopt rules 23 concerning the adapting, fitting, duplicating, dispensing, selling, and 24 supplying of contact lenses by licensed dispensing opticians, including 25 establishing appropriate educational requirements of licensed dispensing 26 opticians. 27 (b) A licensed dispensing optician shall: (1) Fit contact lenses only upon a written prescription from a 28 29 licensed optometrist or licensed physician skilled in disease of the eye; 30 (2) Advise the intended wearer of the contact lenses at the time of dispensing to return to the licensed optometrist or licensed physician 31 32 skilled in disease of the eye for evaluation and follow-up care; 33 (3) Not fit a generic type of contact lenses or mode of wear for 34 contact lenses contrary to the type or mode prescribed; and 35 (4) Not duplicate contact lenses solely from previously prepared 36 contact lenses.
