16	TO MODIFY THE DEFINITION OF "OPHTHALMIC
17	DISPENSING" TO INCLUDE THE PREPARATION
18	AND DISPENSING OF CONTACT LENSES.

21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22	
23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-89-102(4), concerning the definition of
24	"ophthalmic dispensing", is amended to read as follows:
25	(4)(A) "Ophthalmic dispensing" means the preparation of
26	laboratory work orders, verification, and dispensing of spectacle lenses,
27	spectacles, eyeglasses, or parts thereof, or contact lenses to the intended
28	wearer on a written prescription from a licensed physician skilled in disease
29	of the eye or from a licensed optometrist.
30	(B) "Opthalmic Ophthalmic dispensing" shall include
31	includes:
32	(i) The measuring, fitting, adapting, and adjusting
33	of spectacle lenses, spectacles, eyeglasses, or parts thereof to the human
34	face;
35	(ii) The preparation and delivery of work orders to
36	laboratory technicians engaged in grinding lenges and fabrication of everyear.

1	(iii) The verification of the quality of finished
2	spectacle lenses, spectacles, or eyeglasses; and
3	(iv) The adjustment or repair of spectacle frames to
4	the human face; and
5	(v) The dispensing, selling, or supplying of contact
6	lenses by a licensed dispensing optician.
7	(C) The prescribing, adapting, fitting, duplicating,
8	dispensing, or modifying, selling, or supplying of contact lenses for or to
9	the human eye is specifically excluded;
10	
11	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 89, Subchapter 4, is
12	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
13	17-89-409. Contact lenses.
14	(a) The Arkansas Board of Dispensing Opticians shall adopt rules
15	concerning the dispensing, selling, and supplying of contact lenses by
16	licensed dispensing opticians, including establishing appropriate educational
17	requirements of licensed dispensing opticians.
18	(b) A licensed dispensing optician shall:
19	(1) Dispense contact lenses only upon a written prescription
20	from a licensed optometrist or licensed physician skilled in disease of the
21	eye;
22	(2) Advise the intended wearer of the contact lenses at the time
23	of dispensing to return to the licensed optometrist or licensed physician
24	skilled in disease of the eye for evaluation and follow-up care;
25	(3) Not fit a generic type of contact lenses or mode of wear for
26	contact lenses contrary to the type or mode prescribed; and
27	(4) Not duplicate contact lenses solely from previously prepared
28	contact lenses.
