22 STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 11, Chapter 10, Subchapter 1, is
28 amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

29 11-10-112. Labor market data – Collection of data.

30 (a) Except as provided under subsection (b) of this section, under
31 this chapter an employer that employs an individual in this state shall
32 participate in any labor market information survey that is conducted by the
33 Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor by
34 completing without limitation:

35 (1) A Multiple Worksite Report;

36 (2) An Industry Verification Form; and

- 1 (3) An Occupational Employment Statistics survey.
- 2 (b) This section applies to an employer with twenty-five (25) or more
- 3 employees.
- 4 (c) The Department of Workforce Services shall use labor market data
- 5 to enable the department to serve an employer.
