1 INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2019-140 2 REQUESTING THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL REFER TO THE HOUSE 3 COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE, AND LABOR A STUDY OF A 4 5 POSSIBLE REQUIREMENT THAT A PERSON LAWFULLY CARRYING A CONCEALED 6 HANDGUN USE A RESTRAINT HOLSTER THAT DECREASES THE LIKELIHOOD OF 7 A CONCEALED HANDGUN BEING DROPPED OR OTHERWISE MISPLACED AND 8 INCREASES THE SAFETY OF BOTH THE PERSON CARRYING THE CONCEALED 9 HANDGUN AND THE PUBLIC IN GENERAL. 10 WHEREAS, "restraint holster" generally means a holster capable of 11 12 carrying or storing a concealed handgun on the body of a person and that has 13 at least two (2) of the following restraints designed to secure the concealed 14 handgun: 15 (1) Thumb strap; 16 (2) Mechanical lock; or 17 (3) Adjustable tension; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the use of a restraint holster provides an extra level of 20 safety and security for a person who is lawfully carrying a concealed handgun 21 by preventing the accidental dropping of the handgun that may occur when a 22 holster that is not a restraint holster is used; and 23 24 WHEREAS, a study of a possible requirement that a person who is 25 lawfully carrying a concealed handgun use a restraint holster would provide 26 the General Assembly with the necessary information to determine whether 27 legislation designed to protect the handgun owner and the public at large 28 should be considered by the General Assembly; and 29 30 WHEREAS, given the safety implications of properly securing a lawfully 31 carried concealed handgun, the House Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and 32 Labor is the appropriate committee to conduct this study, 33 34 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROPOSED BY THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE NINETY-SECOND 35 36 GENERAL ASSEMBLY:
