1 INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2019-163 2 REQUESTING THE UNIFORM PERSONNEL CLASSIFICATION AND COMPENSATION 3 4 PLAN SUBCOMMITTEE OF THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY THE 5 POSSIBILITY OF ALLOWING CERTAIN STATE EMPLOYEES TO RECEIVE VALUE 6 FOR A PORTION OF THEIR ACCRUED LEAVE IN LIEU OF FORFEITING THAT 7 LEAVE. 8 9 WHEREAS, under the Uniform Attendance and Leave Policy Act, Arkansas 10 Code § 21-4-201 et seq., a state employee may accrue up to thirty (30) days of annual leave at the end of each calendar year; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, while accrued leave cannot exceed thirty (30) days at the end 14 of the calendar year, it may exceed thirty (30) days prior to the end of the 15 calendar year; and 16 17 WHEREAS, under the policies of the Office of Personnel Management, an 18 employee's accrued leave that exceeds thirty (30) days at the end of the 19 calendar year will be forfeited or may be donated to the Office of Personnel 20 Management Catastrophic Leave Bank; and 21 22 WHEREAS, the accrual of annual leave is part of a state employee's 23 compensation package and has value to the employee; and 24 25 WHEREAS, it is in the interest of a state employee to use his or her 26 accrued annual leave that exceeds thirty (30) days prior to the end of the 27 calendar year to avoid forfeiting that annual leave; and 28 29 WHEREAS, certain state employees who work in critical-need areas with 30 24/7 operations face challenges in using accrued leave that exceeds thirty 31 (30) days due to the staffing needs of the state agency at issue; and 32 33 WHEREAS, these state employees provide valuable services, often in high-risk settings such as correctional facilities, and should not be 34 35 penalized by the forfeiture of accrued leave while they fulfill the duties of 36 their employment; and

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1 2 WHEREAS, legislators should study possible revisions to state law to provide relief to these employees and allow them to receive value for the 3 4 accrued leave they are required to forfeit due to the nature of their 5 employment, 6 7 NOW THEREFORE, 8 BE IT PROPOSED BY THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL: 9 10 THAT the Uniform Personnel Classification and Compensation Plan Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative Council study possible legislation 11 12 to allow certain state employees in critical-need areas with 24/7 operations such as the Department of Corrections, Department of Health, Department of 13 14 Human Services, the Division of Emergency Management, the Division of 15 Arkansas State Police, and the Department of Veterans Affairs, to receive value for accrued leave that they would otherwise forfeit while fulfilling 16 17 the duties of their employment. 18 19 BE IT FURTHER PROPOSED THAT the possible legislation to be studied 20 include the potential payout of the value of forfeited leave if the state 21 employee requested to use the leave but his or her request was denied to 22 ensure proper staffing of the state agency at issue. 23 24 BE IT FURTHER PROPOSED THAT the Office of Personnel Management be 25 invited to participate in the study. 26 27 Respectfully submitted, 28 29 30 31 Senator Kim Hammer 32 District 33 33 34 Prepared by: MBM/MBM 35 36

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
