1 INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2021-001 2 REQUESTING THAT THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY STUDY ALL 3 4 FINANCIAL DISTRIBUTIONS RELATED TO THE DISTRICT COURT SYSTEM, SPECIFICALLY DISTRIBUTIONS FROM THE STATE ADMINISTRATION OF 5 6 JUSTICE FUND, TO ADDRESS THE UNEVEN DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS AMONG 7 THE STATE, COUNTIES, AND MUNICIPALITIES AND ANY RELATED 8 LEGISLATION THAT MAY BE NECESSARY TO CORRECT INEQUITIES. 9 10 WHEREAS, since the passage of Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 80, the 11 General Assembly has put in place many laws to redefine the jurisdiction and 12 organization of the district court system in Arkansas; and 13 14 WHEREAS, the General Assembly has focused on the collection and 15 distribution of court costs and other fines and fees to support a variety of 16 state entities and programs with little regard for local governmental need 17 and ability to collect moneys; and 18 19 WHEREAS, historically, cities and towns have paid most of the costs 20 related to the operation of municipal and city courts while the State of 21 Arkansas has not paid any costs and the counties have paid very few, and the 22 practice continues to this day in most district courts; and 23 24 WHEREAS, since district courts are now an integral part of the state's 25 three-tiered judicial system and the State of Arkansas, as well as many 26 counties, receives significant revenue from that system while paying little 27 or nothing to operate the district courts, an inequity exists that should be 28 studied and addressed by the General Assembly; and 29 30 WHEREAS, a fair and equitable system to share the operational costs of 31 a district court would be to divide the operational costs on a pro rata basis 32 based on the use of the district court by all branches of government; and 33 WHEREAS, during the 2013 Regular Session, the Eighty-Ninth General 34 35 Assembly recognized the merit of such a system on a limited basis by passing

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     Acts 2013, No. 1346, codified in part as § 16-17-108(47)(B)(i) and (ii),
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    which requires that the pro rata computation be used in Lonoke County; and
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           WHEREAS, substantial amounts of money are collected by the district
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     court system in the form of court costs, fees, and fines; and
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           WHEREAS, the State of Arkansas receives through the State
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     Administration of Justice Fund a significant portion of the moneys collected
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     by district courts and pays nothing to local governments to assist with the
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     operational costs of the district courts; and
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           WHEREAS, financial matters concerning the distribution of moneys
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     collected by the district courts are inextricably linked to a fair and
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     equitable local court system and ultimately should be addressed by the
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     General Assembly,
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     NOW THEREFORE,
     BE IT PROPOSED BY THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY OF THE NINETY-THIRD
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     GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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           THAT the House Committee on Judiciary conduct an interim study of all
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     financial distributions related to the district court system, including
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     without limitation distributions from the State Administration of Justice
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     Fund, the operational costs of district courts, the distribution of court
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     costs, fees, and fines, whether the operational costs are proportionately
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     divided among the state, counties, and municipalities, and any related
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     legislation that may be necessary to correct inequities.
