18	TO CREATE THE ACUITY-BASED CARE

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26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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28	SECTION 1. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. DO NOT CODIFY. Acuity-Based Care
29	<u>Committee — Creation — Membership — Duties.</u>
30	(a) There is created the Acuity-Based Care Committee to study nurse
31	staffing in all hospitals, rehabilitation facilities, and long-term care
32	facilities.
33	(b) The committee shall consist of the following members:
34	(1) A member of the House Committee on Public Health, Welfare,
35	and Labor appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

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1	(2) A member of the Senate Committee on Public Health, Welfare,						
2	and Labor appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;						
3	(3) A representative of the Department of Health;						
4	(4) A representative of the Department of Human Services;						
5	(5) A representative of the Arkansas Hospital Association, Inc.;						
6	(6) A representative of the Arkansas Nurses Association;						
7	(7) A representative of the Arkansas State Board of Nursing;						
8	(8) A representative of the Arkansas Health Care Association;						
9	(9) A representative of the Arkansas Rural Health Partnership;						
10	(10) A representative of the Arkansas Minority Health						
11	Commission;						
12	(11) A representative of the Arkansas Center for Nursing, Inc.;						
13	(12) A representative of the Arkansas Organization of Nurse						
14	Executives;						
15	(13) A representative of the Arkansas Chapter of the Alzheimer's						
16	Association;						
17	(14) A representative of the Arkansas State Office of AARP,						
18	Inc.;						
19	(15) A representative of the Arkansas Emergency Nurses						
20	Association;						
21	(16) A representative of the Arkansas Nursing Home Nurses						
22	Association;						
23	(17) A representative of the Arkansas Chapter of the American						
24	Association of Critical Care Nurses;						
25	(18) A representative of Blue Cross Blue Shield; and						
26	(19) A representative of Centene Corporation.						
27	(c) If a vacancy occurs on the committee, the vacancy shall be filled						
28	by the same process as the original appointment.						
29	(d) The legislative members of the committee shall be paid per diem						
30	and mileage as authorized by law for attendance at meetings of interim						
31	committees of the General Assembly.						
32	(e)(1) The Director of the Department of Health shall call the first						
33	meeting of the committee within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this						
34	act and shall serve as chair at the first meeting.						

1	(2) At the first meeting of the <i>committee</i> , the members of the
2	committee shall elect from the committee's membership a chair or cochairs and
3	other officers as needed for the transaction of its business.
4	(3)(A) The <i>committee</i> shall meet at the Department of Health.
5	(B) Meetings of the <i>committee</i> shall be held at least
6	one (1) time every three (3) months but may occur more often at the call of
7	the chair or cochairs.
8	(4) The <i>committee</i> shall establish rules and procedures for
9	conducting its business.
10	(5)(A) A majority of the members of the <i>committee</i> shall
11	constitute a quorum for transacting business of the committee.
12	(B) An affirmative vote of a majority of a quorum present
13	shall be required for the passage of a motion or other <i>committee</i> action.
14	(6) The Department of Health shall provide staff, meeting space,
15	and materials for the <i>committee</i> .
16	(f)(1) The purpose of the committee is to examine and identify areas
17	of needed reform with regard to the protocol, procedures, and mechanisms
18	related to current nurse staffing practices in all hospitals, rehabilitation
19	facilities, and long-term care facilities.
20	(2) To achieve this purpose, the <i>committee</i> shall:
21	(A) Study practices and protocols of other states with
22	regard to nurse staffing;
23	(B) Consult stakeholders and interested parties in the
24	state; and
25	(C) Develop best practices and recommended protocols,
26	including identifying areas of needed statutory or regulatory reform with
27	regard to nurse staffing.
28	(g) On or before March 1, 2022, the committee shall file with the
29	House Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor and the Senate Committee
30	on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor a final written report of the
31	committee's activities, findings, and recommendations.
32	(h) The committee shall expire on March 1, 2022.
