31	<u>(1) "Consumer reporti</u>	ing agency" means an agency as defined by
32	the Fair Credit Reporting Act, 15	U.S.C. § 1681 et seq., as it existed on
33	<u>January 1, 2021;</u>	
34	<u>(2) "Payroll data pro</u>	ovider" means payroll providers,
35	verification companies, and other	commercial or noncommercial entities that
36	<u>collect and maintain data regardin</u>	ng employment and income; and

1	(3) "Real-time employment and income data" means up-to-date,		
2	nonmodeled employment and income data provided by employers.		
3	(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or regulation to the		
4	contrary, in order to improve the timeliness of benefit deliveries,		
5	operational efficiencies, and cost savings and to minimize fraud, the		
6	Department of Human Services and the Division of Workforce Services may		
7	participate in a no-cost pilot program in which real-time employment and		
8	income data is obtained from a payroll data provider that is a consumer		
9	reporting agency for the purpose of assisting with the determination of an		
10	individual's eligibility to receive the following benefits:		
11	(1) Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program;		
12	(2) Temporary Assistance for Needy Families; and		
13	(3) Unemployment.		
14	(c) The real-time employment and income data obtained under subsection		
15	(b) of this section may also be used to conduct an analysis on the pilot		
16	program.		
17	(d) Should the pilot program successfully demonstrate cost savings,		
18	the department and the division may incorporate the real-time employment and		
19	income data into the eligibility verification determination processes.
