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27	SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Uterine disease and uterine health issues</u>		
28	study.		
29	(a) The University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences shall conduct a		
30	study on uterine diseases and uterine health issues in Arkansas, including		
31	without limitation:		
32	(1) The research on uterine diseases and uterine health issues		
33	being conducted within the state;		
34	(2) The available technical assistance, educational materials,		
35	and support programs for patients with uterine diseases nationwide;

1	(3) The level of public and professional awareness about uterine			
2	diseases;			
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4	and their caregivers;			
5	(5) The needs of healthcare providers in regard to caring for a			
6	patient with a uterine disease;			
7	(6) The services available to a patient with a uterine disease;			
8	(7) The existence of uterine disease treatment programs; and			
9	(8) The existence of support groups for patients with uterine			
10	disease.			
11	(b) On or before September 30, 2021, the university shall report to			
12	the:			
13	(1) Senate Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor;			
14	(2) House Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor;			
15	(3) President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and			
16	(4) Speaker of the House of Representatives.			
17	(c) The report described in subsection (b) of this section shall			
18	<u>include:</u>			
19	(1) Information and statistics regarding the types of uterine			
20	diseases and conditions that are prevalent in this state, including without			
21	limitation uterine fibroids;			
22	(2) Information as to whether any health disparities exist			
23	regarding uterine diseases or uterine health issues;			
24	(3) The financial impact and reach that uterine diseases of all			
25	types are having on each agency, locality, and the state;			
26	(4) An assessment of the benefits of implemented programs and			
27	activities that:			
28	(A) Aims at controlling uterine diseases and preventing			
29	uterine diseases; and			
30	(B) Documents the amount and source for funding directed			
31	to the agency or entity from the General Assembly for programs and activities			
32	aimed at reaching individuals with uterine diseases; and			
33	(5) Recommendations to increase awareness of uterine diseases			
34	and uterine health issues; and			
35	(6) Recommendations for any legislation regarding uterine			
36	diseases or uterine health issues.
