16	<u>23-79-2401. Definitions.</u>	
17	As used in this subchapter:	
18	(1) "Birth mother" means the biological mother of a child;	
19	(2) "Depression" means a mental illness classified as a mood	
20	disorder that causes a persistent feeling of sadness and a loss of interest;	
21	(3)(A) "Health benefit plan" means:	
22	<u>(i) An individual, blanket, or group plan or a</u>	
23	policy, or contract for healthcare services issued or delivered by a	
24	healthcare insurer; and	
25	(ii) Any health benefit program receiving state or	
26	federal appropriations from the State of Arkansas, including the Arkansas	
27	Medicaid Program and the Arkansas Health and Opportunity for Me Program, or	
28	any successor program.	
29	(B) "Health benefit plan" includes:	
30	(i) Indemnity and managed care plans; and	
31	(ii) Nonfederal governmental plans as defined in 29	
32	<u>U.S.C. § 1002(32), as it existed on January 1, 2024.</u>	
33	(C) "Health benefit plan" does not include:	
34	(i) A disability income plan;	
35	(ii) A credit insurance plan;	

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1	(iii) Insurance coverage issued as a supplement to		
2	liability insurance;		
3	(iv) A medical payment under automobile or		
4	homeowner's insurance plans;		
5	(v) A health benefit plan provided under Arkansas		
6	Constitution, Article 5, § 32, the Workers' Compensation Law, § 11-9-101 et		
7	seq., or the Public Employee Workers' Compensation Act, § 21-5-601 et seq.;		
8	(vi) A plan that provides only indemnity for		
9	hospital confinement;		
10	(vii) An accident-only plan;		
11	(viii) A specified disease plan;		
12	(ix) A long-term-care-only plan;		
13	(x) A dental-only plan; or		
14	(xi) A vision-only plan;		
15	(4) "Healthcare insurer" means an entity subject to the		
16	insurance laws of this state or the jurisdiction of the Insurance		
17	Commissioner that contracts or offers to contract to provide health insurance		
18	coverage, including without limitation an insurance company, a health		
19	maintenance organization, a hospital medical service corporation, a self-		
20	insured governmental or church plan in this state, or the Arkansas Medicaid		
21	Program; and		
22	(5) "Healthcare professional" means a person who is licensed,		
23	certified, or otherwise authorized by the laws of this state to administer		
24	health care in the ordinary course of the practice of his or her profession.

26	23-79-2402. Coverage for birth mother screening for depression.		
27	(a) A healthcare insurer that offers, issues, or renews a health		
28	benefit plan in this state shall provide coverage for screening for		
29	depression of the birth mother by a healthcare professional at the time of		
30	birth on or after January 1, 2024.		
31	(b) The coverage for screening for depression of the birth mother		
32	under this section:		
33	(1) Is not subject to policy deductibles or copayment		
34	requirements; and		
35	(2) Does not diminish or limit benefits otherwise allowable		
36	<u>under a health benefit plan.</u>		

(c) Coverage provided for screening under subsection (a) of this
section for a government self-insured plan is subject to any health benefit
plan provisions that apply to other services covered by the health benefit
plan.
