2	authority also extends to drugs listed in Schedule II if:		
3	(i) The prescription is for an opioid and the		
4	prescription is only for a five-day period or less; or		
5	(ii)(a) The prescription is for a stimulant.		
6	(b) A prescription for a stimulant shall meet		
7	the following criteria:		
8	(1) The prescription was originally		
9	initiated by a physician;		
10	(2) The physician has evaluated the		
11	patient within six (6) months before the advanced practice registered nurse		
12	issues a prescription; and		
13	(3) The prescription by the advanced		
14	practice registered nurse is to treat the same condition as the original		
15	prescription.

17	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-87-310, concerning prescriptive		
18	authority for an advanced practice registered nurse, is amended to add an		
19	additional subsection to read as follows:		
20	(f) An advanced practice registered nurse shall provide the following		
21	information to the Arkansas State Board of Nursing to renew his or her		
22	prescriptive authority:		
23	(1) A report from the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program for		
24	the previous six (6) months of his or her prescriptive authority activity;

26	(2) Documentation indicating that the advanced practice		
27	registered nurse has completed at least ten (10) hours of continuing		
28	education related to conditions frequently managed with controlled		
29	substances.

31	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 20-7-604(d), concerning requirements for		
32	the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program, is amended to add an additional		
33	subdivision to read as follows:		
34	(4) An advanced practice registered nurse shall check the		
35	information in the program before prescribing any controlled substance.
