18	TO AUTHORIZE CERTAIN MEDICAL
19	PROFESSIONALS TO CERTIFY TO THE OFFICE OF
20	MOTOR VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY FOR A SPECIAL
21	LICENSE PLATE, CERTIFICATE, OR PARKING
22	DECAL FOR A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY.
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25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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27	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-80-120(a)(1), concerning the signature
28	authority for advanced practice registered nurses and physician assistants,
29	is amended to read as follows:
30	(1) Certification of disability for patients to receive disabled
31	parking permits or placards from the Office of Motor Vehicle to the Office of
32	Motor Vehicle that a patient is a person with a disability for the purposes
33	of the Access to Parking for Persons with Disabilities Act, § 27-15-301 et
34	seq.; or

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1	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 93, Subchapter 1, is amended
2	to add an additional section to read as follows:
3	17-93-104. Certification for purposes of the Access to Parking for
4	Persons with Disabilities Act.
5	(a) A physical therapist licensed under this chapter is authorized to
6	certify to the Office of Motor Vehicle that a patient is a person with a
7	disability for the purposes of the Access to Parking for Persons with
8	Disabilities Act, § 27-15-301 et seq.
9	(b) This section does not expand the scope of practice of a physical
10	therapist.
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12	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 27-15-302(4), concerning the definition of
13	"person with a disability" within the Access to Parking for Persons with
14	Disabilities Act, is amended to read as follows:
15	(4) "Person with a disability" means any individual who, as determined
16	by a licensed physician certifying authority:
17	(A) Cannot walk one hundred feet (100') without stopping
18	to rest;
19	(B) Cannot walk without the use of, or assistance from, a
20	brace, cane, crutch, another person, prosthetic device, wheelchair, or other
21	assistive device;
22	(C) Is restricted by lung disease to such an extent that
23	the person's forced respiratory expiratory volume for one (1) second, when
24	measured by spirometry, is less than one liter (1 L), or the arterial oxygen
25	tension is less than sixty millimeters of mercury (60 mmHg) on room air at
26	rest;
27	(D) Uses portable oxygen; or
28	(E) Has a cardiac condition to the extent that the
29	person's functional limitations are classified in severity as Class III or
30	Class IV according to standards set by the American Heart Association;
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32	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 27-15-302, concerning definitions within
33	the Access to Parking for Persons with Disabilities Act, is amended to add an
34	additional subdivision to read as follows:
35	(8) "Certifying authority" means:

(A) A licensed physician;

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1	(B) An advanced practice registered nurse as authorized
2	under § 17-80-120;
3	(C) A physician assistant as authorized under § 17-80-120;
4	<u>or</u>
5	(D) A physical therapist as authorized under § 17-93-104.
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7	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 27-15-304(a)(1), concerning temporary
8	special certificates under the Access to Parking for Persons with
9	Disabilities Act, is amended to read as follows:
10	(a)(1) A person with a disability , which, as determined by a licensed
11	physician, is certifying authority to be temporary in nature as opposed to
12	permanent, may apply to the Office of Motor Vehicle for a temporary person-
13	with-a-disability special certificate, which may include a temporary van-
14	accessible parking decal, and, upon request, one (1) additional temporary
15	special certificate, which may include an additional van-accessible parking
16	decal.
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18	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 27-15-307(8)(B), concerning the
19	administration of the Access to Parking for Persons with Disabilities Act, is
20	amended to read as follows:
21	(B) Verify with a letter from a physician certifying
22	authority stating that the person for whom the van-accessible parking decal
23	is issued is a person with a disability that requires the use of a
24	wheelchair, a three-wheeled or four-wheeled scooter, a four-wheeled walker
25	with a seat, or a similar device that is commonly used to transport persons
26	who have limited or no use of their legs.
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28	SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 27-15-308(a)(3)-(4), concerning the
29	eligibility for and renewal of a special license plate or certificate for a
30	person with a disability within the Access to Parking for Persons with
31	Disabilities Act, is amended to read as follows:
32	(3)(A)(i) An owner of a motor vehicle that is issued a special
33	license plate under this section shall submit every four (4) years to the
34	Office of Motor Vehicle a physician recertification of the person with a
35	disability to be transported by the vehicle to continue to qualify for the
36	special license plate, unless the person with a disability has a permanent

1	disability The Office of Motor Vehicle shall require recertification of the
2	condition of the person with a disability by a certifying authority one (1)
3	time every four (4) years for a disability that is temporary in nature.
4	(ii) Recertification shall not be required for a
5	disability that is permanent in nature.
6	(B) The photo identification card required in this
7	subsection must be renewed every four (4) years.
8	(4)(A) An organization that owns or leases a motor vehicle
9	described in § $27-15-303$ that is used in the business of transporting persons
10	with disabilities may apply to the Office of Motor Vehicle for issuance of
11	one (1) special license plate to be affixed to the vehicle for each vehicle
12	used in the business.
13	(B) The requirements of a photo identification card and
14	physician recertification in this subsection recertification provisions of
15	subdivisions (a)(3)(A)-(B) of this section shall not apply to an applicant in
16	the business of transporting persons with disabilities as described in this
17	subsection.
