1	(b) A remote ultrasound and remote fetal nonstress test shall be
2	reimbursable when the healthcare provider uses digital technology that:
3	(1) Collects medical and other forms of health data from a
4	patient and electronically transmits the information securely to a healthcare
5	provider in a different location for interpretation and recommendation;
6	(2) Is compliant with the Health Insurance Portability and
7	Accountability Act of 1996, 42 U.S.C. § 1320d et seq., as it existed on
8	January 1, 2025; and
9	(3) Is approved by the United States Food and Drug
10	Administration.
11	(c) A remote fetal nonstress test shall be reimbursed under a Current
12	Procedural Terminology code 5905 in the same manner as an in-person clinic
13	fetal nonstress test with the place of service at home and shall use remote
14	monitoring solutions that are approved by the United States Food and Drug
15	Administration for on-label use for monitoring fetal heart rate, maternal
16	heart rate, and uterine activity.
17	(d) The Department of Human Services shall:
18	(1) Apply for any federal waiver, Medicaid state plan
19	amendments, or other authority necessary to implement this section; and
20	(2) Adopt rules to implement this section.
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22	SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Rules.</u>
23	(a) When adopting the initial rules required under this act, the
24	Department of Human Services shall file the final rules with the Secretary of
25	State for adoption under § 25-15-204(f):
26	(1) On or before January 1, 2026; or
27	(2) If approval under § 10-3-309 has not occurred by January 1,
28	2026, as soon as practicable after approval under § 10-3-309.
29	(b) The department shall file the proposed rules with the Legislative
30	Council under § 10-3-309(c) sufficiently in advance of January 1, 2026, so
31	that the Legislative Council may consider the rules for approval before
32	January 1, 2026.
