7	(B) An assisted-living facility;	
8	(C) A center or group home for individuals with

14	(H) An intermediate care facility;	
15	(I) An intermediate care facility for individuals with

29	A dialysis patient care technician may administer hemodialysis,	
30	including administering associated medications and central venous catheter	
31	access and care, under the authority of a registered nurse licensed in this	
32	state who may delegate tasks based on nursing judgment to a dialysis patient	
33	care technician based on the dialysis patient care technician's education,	
34	knowledge, training, and skill.

1	(a) To register as a dialysis patient care technician, an individual		
2	shall:		
3	(1) Possess a high school diploma or a general educational		
4	development certificate;		
5	(2) Demonstrate that he or she is:		
6	(A) Employed as a dialysis patient care technician; or		
7	(B) Enrolled in a training course that follows national		
8	recommendations for dialysis patient care technicians and is conducted		
9	primarily in the work setting;		
10	(3)(A) Obtain national certification by successful passage of a		
11	certification examination within eighteen (18) months of becoming employed as		
12	a dialysis patient care technician.		
13	(B)(i) A dialysis patient care technician shall recertify		
14	national certification at intervals required by the organization providing		
15	the certification examination.		
16	(ii) The intervals required under subdivision		
17	(a)(3)(B)(i) of this section shall include no fewer than thirty (30) and no		
18	more than forty (40) patient contact hours since the previous certification		
19	or recertification;		
20	(4) Submit an application with the Arkansas State Board of		
21	Nursing; and		
22	(5) Pay the applicable fee as determined by the board.		
23	(b)(l) An applicant for registration as a dialysis patient care		
24	technician shall report to the board, in writing, any conviction for a felony		
25	or misdemeanor.		
26	(2) A conviction is not a disqualification for registration		
27	under this section unless the conviction relates to the criminal offenses		
28	<u>listed in § 17-3-102.</u>		
29	(c)(l) An applicant or a dialysis patient care technician may report		
30	any pardon or setting aside of a conviction to the board.		
31	(2) If a pardon or setting aside has been obtained, the		
32	conviction for which the pardon or setting aside was obtained shall not be		
33	maintained on the Dialysis Patient Care Technician Registry created under §		
34	<u>17-87-906.</u>		
35	(d) If a person registered as a dialysis patient care technician		
36	becomes licensed as a registered nurse or licensed practical nurse, his or		

1	her registration as a dialysis patient care technician shall terminate as of	
2	the date of licensure as a registered nurse or a licensed practical nurse.

4	17-87-906. Dialysis Patient Care Technician Registry — Contents of	
5	registry.	
6	(a)(1) The Arkansas State Board of Nursing shall list each dialysis	
7	patient care technician registrant on a registry to be named the "Dialysis	
8	Patient Care Technician Registry".	
9	(2) A listing in the registry is valid for the term of the	
10	registration and upon renewal unless the listing is refused renewal or is	
11	removed.	
12	(b) The registry shall contain the following information on each	
13	person who is a registered dialysis patient care technician:	
14	(1) The individual's full name;	
15	(2) Any conviction of a felony or misdemeanor reported to the	
16	board;	
17	(3) A certificate showing completion of a nationally recognized	
18	training program; and	
19	(4) A certificate of completion of a nationally commercially	
20	available dialysis patient care technician certification examination.

22	17-87-907. Construction.

24	register as a medication assistive person under § 17-87-701 et seq.
