- One time funding.
- Program mirrors similar federal program.
- Focus is to enhance nonprofit entities to prevent, protect against, prepare for, and respond to terrorist or other extremist attacks. It will allow funding to support physical security enhancements and other security activities.
- Eligibility criteria:
 - Must be described under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1986 (IRC) and exempt from tax under section 501(a) of such code.
 - Able to demonstrate, through the application, that the organization is at high risk of a terrorist or other extremist attack.
 - Each nonprofit must include its mission statement and any mission implementation policies or practices that may elevate the organization's risk.
 - The nonprofit must be an ideology-based/spiritual/religious organization.
- Examples of items that qualify for grant funding:
 - o Security/Police presence/Contract Security Personnel
 - Security cameras/video cameras/lighting/motion sensors
 - Perimeter Protection (Gate/Fence)
 - Access control to buildings
 - Trip Wire Alarms
 - Vehicle Barriers
- Consideration will be given to recent threats. Arkansas State Police will verify the threats and evaluate creditability.
