Report to Legislative Council on Acts or Parts of Acts from the 2024 Fiscal Session to be Indexed as Local, Special, or Temporary Acts

1. Act No. 172, § 1: Market adjustment for certain state employees

Section 1 of this act provides that an employee under the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, § 21-5-201 et seq., may receive a one-time market adjustment of up to three percent (3%) of the employee's base salary. The section is effective on and after July 1, 2024, and expires June 30, 2025.
