# A. Summary of Grant Activities

The Right to Worship Safely (RTWS) Grant opened in January of 2024. The Department of Public Safety received thirty-one (31) applications with requests totaling \$2,139,421.00. Six (6) of these applications met the qualifications and were awarded a total of \$227,792.00 in February 2024. All award checks were processed by fiscal and mailed by the close of March 2024.

### **B.** Status Update on Future Activities

The RTWS Grant has a remaining balance of \$272,208.00. DPS plans to open the grant again later in the FY25 fiscal year (September 2024) to award the remaining funds.

#### C. Status of Deliverables

Grant awardees will submit their quarterly reports by May 31, 2024, to DPS. At this time, we will receive updates on how the funds were spent and what progress they have made in supporting physical security enhancements and other security activity projects serving to assist their nonprofit ideology-based/spiritual/religious entities in the prevention, protection against, preparedness for, and response to terrorist threat(s) and/or other extremist attack(s).

### D. Key Issues and Technical Assistance Needs

The current guidelines for the RTWS Grant Program only allowed consideration for organizations that received a credible threat in the last twelve (12) months. We are researching if this timeline should expand. Many applicants had viable threats but did not meet the twelve (12) month timeline.

### F. Additional Information

The Department of Public Safety received numerous questions on and interest in the grant program after its initial posting. The number of applications for the next round are expected to be higher.
