Dear Senator Gilmore and Representative Eaves:

Please find enclosed the following reports for your review:

- The CY 2023 Quick Action Closing Fund Annual Report, which is an accounting of the incentive fund as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 19-5-1231; and
- The CY 2023 Foreign Operations Report, which is a report of the State's foreign direct investment and international trade as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 15-4-210.

In Calendar Year 2023, the Arkansas Economic Development Commission (AEDC) worked with companies to sign incentive agreements for 78 projects that are projected to create and/or retain 4,502 jobs and stimulate approximately \$2.3 billion in new capital investment. In 2023, the projected average wage for projects with a job creation requirement was \$28.49. The cost benefit ratio of these projects was \$4.07/\$1.

In addition, the AEDC's Global Business Team engaged 17 foreign countries throughout Europe and Asia during 2023. These engagements connected the Global Business Team with potential trade partners, prospective companies, and investors to market the positive benefits of doing business with Arkansas.

## GOVERNOR'S QUICKACTION CLOSING FUND REPORT



The Governor's Quick Action Closing Fund (QACF), created in 2007, allows the Governor of Arkansas to act quickly and decisively regarding highly competitive economic development recruitment projects. This discretionary incentive allows the Arkansas Economic Development Commission (AEDC) to finalize an agreement with a prospective company to locate or expand an economic development project. Utilization of these funds, appropriated by the General Assembly, have given AEDC the ability to secure final commitments from companies that have created and retained jobs and new investments in the state.

Since 2007, the QACF has assisted companies to propose 114 job creation and/or retention projects in Arkansas. These projects cumulatively have proposed the creation and/or retention of 44,527 jobs at an average hourly wage of \$26.02 and projected new investment of \$7.6 billion in the state. As of December 31, 2023, these 114 projects have created and retained 37,230 jobs.

The QACF is critical for the state and AEDC to compete on a global level for high quality economic development projects. The continued support from the General Assembly and the Governor has assisted the Commission to recruit, retain, and expand economic development projects.
