7	WHEREAS, Charles James "Charlie" Kirk was assassinated on September 10			
8	2025, at thirty-one (31) years of age; and

10	WHEREAS, during his life, Charlie Kirk was a passionate advocate for			
11	the United States Constitution and the United States of America as well as			
12	for free speech and his Christian faith; and			
13				
14	WHEREAS, Charlie Kirk was born on October 14, 1993, and was raised in			
15	the suburbs of Chicago, Illinois, eventually earning the rank of Eagle Scout			
16	in the Boy Scouts of America; and			
17				
18	WHEREAS, Charlie Kirk became interested in politics during middle			
19	school after reading works by economist Milton Friedman, and during his			
20	junior year of high school, he volunteered for the successful United States			
21	Senate campaign of Illinois Republican Mark Kirk; and			
22	AMERICA (17) (1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1			
23	WHEREAS, at age seventeen (17), Charlie Kirk made his first appearance			
24	on the conservative business news channel Fox Business, an appearance			
2526	prompted by an essay he wrote for the conservative news website Breitbart			
27	News Network; and			
28	WHEREAS, at age eighteen (18), Charlie Kirk co-founded and became			
29	executive director of Turning Point USA, a nonprofit organization dedicated			
30	to identifying, organizing, and empowering young people to promote the			
31	principles of free markets and limited government; and			
32	principles of free markets and finited government, and			
33	WHEREAS, Turning Point USA grew to become one of the largest political			
34	organizations in the United States, encompassing representation at over one			
35	thousand two hundred (1,200) high schools and college campuses nationwide as			
36	well as massive rallies at which top conservative leaders addressed tens of			

1	thousands of young voters; and

3	WHEREAS, Charlie Kirk was a bestselling author, the youngest speaker at			
4	the 2016 Republican National Convention, and host, since 2020, of "The			
5	Charlie Kirk Show", a popular talk radio program; and			
6				
7	WHEREAS, Charlie Kirk generated unprecedented interest in political			
8	conservatism among American youth, espousing and defending, often via			
9	informal college campus debates held at his signature "Prove Me Wrong" table,			
10	a number of conservative stances; and			
11				
12	WHEREAS, President Donald J. Trump ordered the flag of the United			
13	States flown at half-staff as a mark of respect for the memory of Charlie			
14	Kirk; and			
15				
16	WHEREAS, President Trump also announced that Charlie Kirk would be			
17	posthumously awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom,			
18				
19	NOW THEREFORE,			
20	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL			
21	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:			
22				
23	THAT the Legislative Council honor the memory of Charles James			
24	"Charlie" Kirk as an icon of modern American conservatism and a proponent of			
25	his Christian faith.
