PURPOSE:

To present funding recommendations from AEDC Rural Services for the Arkansas Game and Fish Wildlife Grant Program.

BACKGROUND:

Each fiscal year, AEDC Rural Services receives legislative appropriation to award funds from the above named grant programs.

Applications received by AEDC Rural Services go through the following process:

- 1. Reviewed for eligibility by Rural Services staff;
- 2. Eligible applications and rankings are then reviewed by the Rural Development Commission;
- 3. Recommendations are forwarded to the Secretary of Commerce and Governor
- 4. Recommendations are forwarded to Legislative Council for final approval.

COMMUNITIES IMPACTED:

- Arkansas Game and Fish Wildlife Conservation Education Grant Program - There are no population limits associated with this program. This grant program is funded through fines collected from hunting and fishing violations. The funding is county specific, meaning that only fines collected in a county may be used to fund conservation education in that county. As an example, fines collected in Monroe County may not be used to fund conservation education programs in Prairie County. The cap on this program varies by county and year and the program requires no match.
