REQUESTING THAT THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE EIGHTYEIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY ENCOURAGE THE ARKANSAS GAME AND FISH COMMISSION TO ADOPT REGULATIONS PERMITTING THE COMMISSION TO ENTER INTO RECIPROCITY AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER STATES REGARDING NONRESIDENT FISHING PRIVILEGES AND THE FEES CHARGED FOR NONRESIDENT FISHING LICENSES.

WHEREAS, the current fee for an annual nonresident fishing license in Arkansas is forty dollars (\$40.00);

WHEREAS, the current fee for an annual resident fishing license in Arkansas is ten dollars fifty cents (\$10.50);

WHEREAS, Texas, Oklahoma, and Mississippi offer nonresidents certain fishing privileges, including without restriction fishing licenses for the same price as resident fishing licenses, based on reciprocity agreements; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas residents would benefit from reciprocity agreements regarding nonresident fishing privileges and fees for nonresident fishing licenses,

NOW THEREFORE,
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the Arkansas Legislative Council of the Eighty-Eighth General Assembly encourages the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission to adopt regulations permitting the commission to enter into reciprocity agreements with other states regarding nonresident fishing privileges and the fees charged for nonresident fishing licenses.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of this resolution, a copy of this resolution shall be transmitted to the Director of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission.
