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9	WHEREAS, Section 26 of Act 937 of 2011 required the Department of
10	Workforce Services to prepare a study to determine the best and most
11	appropriate way to address the financial needs of grandparents raising
12	grandchildren through the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
13	Block Grant Program; and
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15	WHEREAS, the study concludes that currently, the TANF budget and
16	reserve fund (carry forward fund) does not allow for a new program to be
17	funded and sustained. However, alternative funding streams are offered,
18	specifically the new federal Title IV-E waivers (the Kinship Guardianship
19	Assistance Program) under the Child and Family Services Improvement and
20	Innovation Act; and
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22	WHEREAS, at present, many states already offer subsidized guardianship
23	assistance in some form with all those programs working to promote lasting
24	family relationships for children with the goals of improving the lives of
25	the children and of bringing them out of foster care and into permanent
26	families; and
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28	WHEREAS, Arkansas grandparents who are raising their grandchildren
29	often need financial assistance to maintain an optimal home life; and
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31	WHEREAS, participation in the federal Title IV-E waivers (the Kinship
32	Guardianship Assistance Program) would provide support for those grandparents
33	already raising their grandchildren and would allow grandparents who cannot
34	presently afford to raise their grandchildren to bring those children into a
35	loving home; and

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1	WHEREAS, Arkansas's participation in the federal Title IV-E waivers
2	(the Kinship Guardianship Assistance Program) could provide significant
3	assistance in improving the lives of Arkansas's children,
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5	NOW THEREFORE,
6	BE IT PROPOSED BY THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH
7	GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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9	THAT the Arkansas Legislative Council of the Eighty-Eighth Arkansas
10	General Assembly refer to the Senate Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and
11	Labor a study of the feasibility of seeking a grant for Arkansas
12	participation in the federal Title IV-E waivers (the Kinship Guardianship
13	Assistance Program).
