The Executive Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative Council met **Thursday, April 12, 2012** at 12:00 noon. The members present are listed on the sign-in sheet.

The subcommittee discussed the hiring process for the position of the Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research.

Senator Luker made a motion for the subcommittee to be in executive session to discuss the interview process and their preferences for applicants to be interviewed. The motion was seconded, and carried without objection.

Following the executive session, the subcommittee announced they would like to interview five (5) applicants beginning on Tuesday, April 17, 2012.
