

INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2013-168

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL REFER TO THE INTERIM HOUSE  
COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY A REQUEST TO STUDY CRIMES THAT INVOLVE THE  
USE OF AN AUTOMOBILE TO KILL OR INJURE A PERSON IN ORDER TO  
SUGGEST POSSIBLE LEGISLATION TO AMEND THE HOMICIDE, ASSAULT, AND  
BATTERY STATUTES IN THE CRIMINAL CODE.

BE IT PROPOSED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL  
ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the Legislative Council refer to the Interim House Committee on  
Judiciary a request to study crimes that involve the use of an automobile to  
kill or injure a person in order to suggest possible legislation to amend the  
homicide, assault, and battery statutes in the Criminal Code.

BE IT FURTHER PROPOSED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL  
ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the Legislative Council respectfully requests data, information,  
and input from relevant state agencies, such as the Arkansas Crime  
Information Center, Administrative Office of the Courts, Department of  
Arkansas State Police, local elected law enforcement officials such as county  
sheriffs and prosecuting attorneys, and other law enforcement officials, to  
assist in this study.
