The ALC Game & Fish/State Police Subcommittee met Wednesday, October 16, 2013, at the State Police Administrative Headquarters in Little Rock, Arkansas. Meeting with the Subcommittee were representatives from the Arkansas State Police.

Colonel Stan Witt, Director, Arkansas State Police, presented the Department Report – Objectives & Needs for the 2015-2017 Biennium. Issues of discussion include consideration of an Arkansas Cell Phone Hands Free Law, statewide deployment of twenty-four low profile patrol vehicles, updates to the AFIS (Automated Fingerprint Identification System), and the review of evidence storage and accounting systems. A demonstration of the new Electronic Ticketing Program - eCite was provided.

Representative Henry ‘Hank’ Wilkins IV, presented an update of Act 308 of 2009, Arkansas Primary Seatbelt Law, including the history and passage of adopting a primary seatbelt law in Arkansas.
