3	REQUESTING THAT THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL REFER TO THE
4	SENATE COMMITTEE ON REVENUE AND TAXATION A STUDY CONCERNING AN
5	INCOME TAX EXEMPTION FOR RETIREES OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED
6	FORCES, INCLUDING NATIONAL GUARD AND RESERVE COMPONENTS OF THE
7	ARMED FORCES.

9	WHEREAS, attracting and maintaining residents who plan to retire in
10	Arkansas has a positive economic impact on the state; and
11	
12	WHEREAS, many retirees of the armed forces plan to retire in states
13	that do not have a state income tax or that provide an income tax exemption
14	for retirees of the armed forces; and
15	
16	WHEREAS, exempting the income retirees of the armed forces receive from
17	the military from Arkansas income tax would encourage these retirees to
18	choose Arkansas as the place they intend to retire, which would benefit
19	Arkansas's economy,
20	
21	NOW THEREFORE,
22	BE IT PROPOSED BY THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH
23	GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
24	
25	THAT the Senate Committee on Revenue and Taxation study the impact on
26	the state of creating an income tax exemption for the income retirees of the
27	United States armed forces, including National Guard and reserve components
28	of the armed forces, receive from the military.
