Request for Approval of Transfer from Contingency Fund

Dear Governor Beebe and Mr. Weiss:

In accordance with Act 269 of 2014, I am requesting approval to transfer \$40,000 from the Arkansas Securities Department's (ASD) appropriation for Contingencies to Professional Fees. This amount will be used for a professional services contract to hire an expert to provide testimony related to open investigations being conducted by ASD and to hire a hearing officer to preside over two administrative hearings.

ASD will retain an expert to support its position related to violations of the Arkansas Securities Act, the Rules of the Arkansas Securities Commissioner, related federal statutes, and FINRA regulations in two separate, but related cases, involving St. Bernard Financial Services, Inc., Robert Keenan, and Steele Stephens. The expert will need to be available for testimony at any administrative hearings. It is anticipated that the cost of the expert would be approximately \$15,000, plus travel expenses if testimony is needed at a hearing.

Additionally, ASD needs to contract with a qualified attorney to serve as the hearing officer for the two cases. The total amount of the contract will not exceed \$25,000. The Department is entirely funded from special revenue and has sufficient funds available for this request.
