The Policy Making Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative Council met Thursday, December 17, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. in Room 272. The members present are listed on the sign-in sheet.

#### **Review of Interim Committee Balances**

Representative Hammer, House Co-Chair of the Joint Performance Review Committee ("JPR") was recognized to discuss the request by JPR for an additional allocation of funds for per diem and mileage for JPR. [Exhibit B].

There was discussion by the Subcommittee members on the request. Representative Davis made a motion to zero the out of state travel allocation for JPR and reallocate \$12,000 from House Revenue and Tax, \$14,000 from Legislative Facilities, and \$12,000 from the Joint Committee on Economic and Tax Policy Committee. In addition, Representative Davis moved to encourage restricting per diem for non-members attending the Joint Performance Review Committee.

Representative Ballinger made a substitute motion to reallocate funds from various committees and zero out of state travel funds.

Senator Elliott made a substitute to the substitute motion to defer action until the Policy Making Subcommittee can have more information and ask the full Legislative Council to give final approval of this issue to the Policy Making Subcommittee to take up at its next meeting. The motion was seconded, and, after discussion by the committee, was approved by voice vote.

Dear Senator Clark and Representative McGill:

As Co-Chairs of the Joint Performance Review (JPR) Committee, we respectfully request that an agenda item be considered at the next meeting of the ALC-Policy Making Subcommittee concerning an additional allocation of funds in the same amount as originally allotted for in-state per diem, mileage, and expenses for the JPR Committee.

Under Arkansas Code Annotated 10-3-902, the Joint Performance Review Committee shall have the authority and responsibility to:

- (1) Make random and periodic performance review of specific governmental programs and agencies;
- (2) Conduct investigations into such specific problem areas of the administration of state government as may be brought to the attention of the Joint Performance Review Committee;
- (3) Refer specific problems regarding the operation of state government to appropriate interim committees of the General Assembly for continuing study;
- (4) Conduct hearings on citizen complaints and views regarding the operation of state government and serve as a forum for citizens to air their complaints and suggestions regarding the operation of state government;
- (5) Review the expenditures of the various agencies, departments, and programs of state government to assure that they are being administered in accordance with legislative intent and are being administered in such manner as to provide the taxpayers with the greatest service at the lowest reasonable cost; and
- (6) Make such reports and recommendations to the Governor, the General Assembly, and the Legislative Council as the Joint Performance Review Committee deems necessary or appropriate to promote more effective and efficient operation of state government.

Due to the extensive meeting schedule and the broad range of issues reviewed by the JPR Committee, there is high attendance by both Committee members and non-members, which impacts the funds available to the Committee.
