RE: State Park Property Acquisitions

Dear Ms. Garrity:

The Arkansas Department of Parks and Tourism, State Parks Division (ASP), has recently been approached by generous individuals willing to donate land and property to Arkansas State Parks. The donations are described below and in additional detail in the enclosed documents.

- Petit Jean State Park: A landowner adjacent to the park boundary has offered to donate up to 200 acres, more or less, to the park. It is his desire to pass on his family farm to ASP in order to safeguard the natural resources of the land while allowing for future recreational and educational opportunities on this beautiful piece of Petit Jean mountain property. The only costs associated with the acquisition would be those for appraisal, survey, and associated closing costs/title insurance.
- o Parkin Archeological State Park: An adjacent landowner has donated approximately 5 acres, more or less, to The Archaeological Conservancy and The Archaeological Conservancy would like to pass the donation on to ASP. The acreage has archeological significance due to its location off of the St. Francis River and historic use by the Northern Ohio Cooperage and Lumber Company. The only costs associated with the acquisition would be reimbursement to The Archaeological Conservancy for appraisal, survey, and title costs not to exceed \$1,000.00.

In accordance with A.C.A. § 22-4-106, I am respectfully requesting the Arkansas Legislative Council's (ALC) favorable advice to complete these property acquisitions. Initial approval of the acquisition for Parkin Archeological State Park was granted by the State Parks, Recreation and Travel Commission at their November 17, 2016, meeting. Initial approval of the acquisition for Petit Jean State Park was granted by the State Parks, Recreation and Travel Commission at their January 19, 2017, meeting. Favorable advice from Governor Hutchinson was received on May 12, 2017 (enclosed). I ask that you place our request on the July 21, 2017, ALC agenda. Petit Jean State Park - Proposed Acquisition

Property Description:

Tract 1

Part of the NW ¼ NE ¼ and part of the SW ¼ NE ¼ of Section 34, T-6-N, R-18-W, Conway County, Arkansas being more particularly described as follows:

Any costs for acquisition would be future appraisal, survey, and title commitment policy/title search.



Any costs for acquisition would be reimbursement to the Archaeological Conservancy for costs associated with appraisal, survey, and title commitment policy/title search.


