

## **TRAUMA SYSTEM DEVELOPMENT**

Report of Progress  
December 16, 2009

### Funding:

- ❖ \$20,000,000 funded in Category A reduced to \$19,739,000
- ❖ \$ 5,000,000 funded at \$901,860 then not funded

### Major Activities:

- ❖ Hospital Designation—71 hospitals (list attached) have submitted intent applications and sub grants and initial payments are currently in progress. The formal review process for facilities requesting certification is being developed by a trauma advisory council sub-committee.
- ❖ Emergency Medical Services—Sub grants are in development for State Associations, Training Schools, and Ground and Air Ambulance Services (list attached).
- ❖ Trauma Registry—Hardware and software have been purchased, installed, and distributed to hospitals. Training classes are currently being scheduled for hospital registrars.
- ❖ Trauma Advisory Council—Appointments have been made to the Trauma Advisory Council consistent with Act 393.
- ❖ Program Leadership—A Branch Chief, William Temple, and a Medical Consultant, Dr. Todd Maxson are in place. Registry staff have been hired. Other positions have been advertised or are in the process of advertisement.
- ❖ Call Center—A RFP (Request for Proposal) is in final draft and should be disseminated in January, 2010.
- ❖ Regional TRACS (Trauma Regional Advisory Councils)—seven councils will be established in the state. A Sub-Committee of the Governors Trauma Advisory Council has been established to create recommended guidelines for TRAC development.
- ❖ Communications—A proposal has been presented to the Department of Health, in coordination with the Department of Information Services, to utilize existing AWINS towers to create a statewide VHF emergency communication system.
- ❖ Quality Improvement—A request for proposal is in development to contract for this service.
- ❖ Burn & Hand Services—Data is being collected of current services provided and a proposal will be submitted to the Trauma Advisory Council.
- ❖ Injury Prevention—Staff recruitment is in process to coordinate activities.
- ❖ Rehabilitation Services—A needs assessment is occurring to develop a recommendation for targeting funds.

Dear Senator Steele and Representative Shelby:

The purpose of this letter is to respond to a request Representative Shelby made at the meeting of the House and Senate Interim Committee on Public Health, Welfare and Labor on October 27, 2009. Following the testimony of Donnie Smith, Director of the Center for Health Protection at the Arkansas Department of Health (ADH), Representative Shelby asked if it would be possible for the ADH to provide the Committee with information pertaining to the release of funds to both "emergency medical system care providers or ambulance providers" and Level I-IV "Trauma Centers" pursuant to the Trauma System Act (Act 393 of 2009). The information below sets forth the progress to date in each area as well as our expectations for near-term accomplishments.

With respect to "emergency medical system care providers or ambulance providers", the ADH has worked closely with the Arkansas Ambulance Association, Arkansas Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT) Association, Arkansas Air Ambulance Committee, Arkansas Training Committee, Arkansas Governor's Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Advisory Council, and other emergency service providers across the State to determine the distribution protocol of available trauma funding in this area. As a result of these discussions, the following criteria will be utilized for funding distributions during fiscal year 2010 for Arkansas licensed ambulance services:

1. Arkansas licensed ground ambulance services will receive a base grant amount of \$4,000 each;
2. the services will receive additional funding based on the county populations they serve;

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3. for services providing the only ambulance service to cities with populations of more than 25,000, the city population will be separated from the total county population and the services will receive further funding based on their work in these larger cities; and
4. Arkansas licensed helicopter ambulance services will receive set base grants of \$6,500 each.

Please see the attached documents, entitled "Ambulance Service Block Grants - \$4,000 Base" and "Eligible Air Services - \$6,500 Block Grants", which set forth the specific funding amounts to be provided to each ambulance service.

In addition to the above funding, grants will also be provided to assist with education. Thirty-three Arkansas EMS training sites will each receive \$4,800 in trauma grant funding to cover expenses related to tuition and books for EMTs. The total amount of this funding is \$158,400. To further assist in this area, the ADH has worked with the Arkansas Ambulance and EMT Associations to help provide trauma training throughout the State. The Associations will receive a total of \$100,000 to provide educational courses to licensed medical services personnel.

As you know, 71 hospitals have submitted Trauma Center Designation Intent Applications to the ADH. Each hospital seeking a Level I, II, or III designation will be eligible for one-half of the start-up grant based on a completed and approved intent application. Eligibility for the second half of the grant will result based on a site team visit for designation and a subsequent recommendation by the ADH. Hospitals seeking Level IV designation will be eligible for total start-up grant funding once a recommendation is made based on the application of intent. It is anticipated that initial start-up grants will begin being awarded prior to the end of calendar year 2009.

Please see the attached list of hospitals that have applied and been approved for start-up grants. The county in which the hospital is located, the level of designation, and the total grant amount are also listed for each hospital.

I hope this information will be useful to you. I look forward to working with the Committee as we move through this process.
