#### Abstract

Collections of Gross General Revenues year-to-date of approximately $\$ 5,432.9$ million have decreased $\$ 160.7$ million, or $2.9 \%$, below the $\$ 5,593.6$ million collected last fiscal year-to-date. Net General Revenue Available for Distribution this month of $\$ 418.3$ million decreased $\$ 16.7$ million, or $3.8 \%$, from the $\$ 435$ million available for distribution in June 2009. In accordance with Act 1315 of 1999, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State transferred $\$ 1,956,112.71$ from Corporate Income Tax to the Workforce 2000 Development Fund for a current total of \$23,473,352.52.
