SUBJECT: COLLECTION AND DISTRIBUTION OF GENERAL AND SPECIAL REVENUES - 2009-2010

Attached is the 2009-2010 Annual Revenue Report, which includes various schedules reflecting the collection and distribution of General and Special Revenues for the 2009-2010 fiscal year. In summary, Gross General Revenue collections of approximately \$5,432.9 million decreased \$160.7 million or 2.87% below the \$5,593.6 million collected in fiscal year 2008-09. Adjusted Net General Revenues available for distribution of \$4,323.1 million decreased \$111.6 million or 2.52% below the \$4,434.7 million available for distribution in fiscal year 2008-09. Gross Special Revenues of \$1,673.5 million increased \$5.7 million, or .34% more than the \$1,667.8 million collected in fiscal year 2008-09.
