1 SECTION 38. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
3 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged
4 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the
5 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief
6 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December
7 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or
8 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during
9 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.
10 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the
11 President or Chancellor, will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or
12 upon release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief
13 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the
14 Board approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal
15 year.

16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
17 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

19 SECTION 39. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CLINICAL
21 EXPANSION AND RESEARCH POOL. (a) In order to address personnel needs emerging
22 from expanding medical research and patient care issues and the necessity of
23 recruiting and retaining qualified medical, research, and related support
24 personnel, the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences or its successor
25 is authorized for the 2009-2010 fiscal year a pool of one thousand five
26 hundred (1,500) "Clinical Expansion and Research Pool" positions. These
27 positions are to be used by the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences
28 in the event that the personal services needs resulting from unanticipated
29 clinical or research programs that are initiated during the 2009-2010 fiscal
30 year require additional positions, either in title, in classification, or in
31 number, that are not authorized or contemplated by the General Assembly in
32 Section 1 of this Act.

33 These "Clinical Expansion and Research Pool" positions may also be used to
34 properly classify positions when the University of Arkansas for Medical
35 Sciences does not have a vacant position available with the appropriate
36 title, grade, or salary level. The salary rates for these positions shall

1 not exceed the highest maximum annual salary rate or the highest grade level
2 position authorized by the General Assembly in Section 1 of this Act, as
3 governed by the uniform Classification and Compensation Act of 1969, §21-5-
4 201 et seq., or its successor.

5
6 (b) The University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences is authorized to access
7 the "Clinical Expansion and Research Pool" positions authorized in this
8 Section at any time during the fiscal year when it is determined by the
9 Chancellor of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, subject to the
10 review and approval by the Board of Trustees, that the need for additional
11 positions exists. The Chancellor of the University of Arkansas for Medical
12 Sciences shall provide a quarterly report detailing the justification of
13 allocation of positions from this "Clinical Expansion and Research Pool" to
14 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to the Department of Higher Education,
15 and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee for review.
16 The report shall also include an accounting of the names, titles and salaries
17 of personnel who have been employed in positions established from this pool
18 and the source and duration of funds associated with the positions.

19
20 (c) If the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences requests continuation
21 of any "Clinical Expansion and Research Pool" position(s) as established
22 herein during the next fiscal year, the position(s) must be requested as a
23 new position(s) in the agency's budget request.

24
25 (d) Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency is
26 the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by
27 delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying job titles and the
28 maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. The General Assembly has
29 determined that the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences could be
30 operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that institution.
31 That flexibility is being accomplished by providing a position pool in
32 Subsection (a) of this Section and since the General Assembly has granted the
33 agency broad powers under the growth pool concept, it is both necessary and
34 appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization
35 of the position pool by requiring review of the Legislative Council or Joint
36 Budget Committee in the utilization of the position pool. Therefore, the

requirement of review by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of review by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.

SECTION 40. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 41. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 42. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
