

INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2011-185

REQUESTING THAT THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL DIRECT THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC RETIREMENT AND SOCIAL SECURITY PROGRAMS TO STUDY THE CURRENT STATUS OF RETIREMENT SYSTEMS AND BENEFITS FOR JUDGES.

WHEREAS, multiple public retirement systems provide benefits to judges upon retirement; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the General Assembly to understand how our limited public resources are utilized, including those resources dedicated to public retirement systems; and

WHEREAS, the Joint Committee on Public Retirement and Social Security Programs shall study:

(1) The different retirement systems that serve judges, including the need for multiple systems; and

(2) Whether or not judges may benefit from multiple systems at the same time, and if so under what terms and conditions.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT PROPOSED BY THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the Arkansas Legislative Council direct the Joint Committee on Public Retirement and Social Security Programs to study the current status of retirement systems and benefits for judges.
