Atch. 1

DIRECTOR SALARY INCREASE RESTRICTION. The Arkansas Game and Fish Commission Director shall not receive any salary adjustment that exceeds their June 17, 2024 <u>2025</u> actual salary by more than five percent (5%) without first receiving prior approval from the Legislative Council or if the General Assembly is in regular session, fiscal session, or extraordinary session, the Joint Budget Committee.

It is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect through June 30, 2025 2026.
