Dear Co-Chairs:

In addition to the requests outlined in the budget manual, the Department of Veterans Affairs (ADVA) plans to propose merging our four separate business areas into a single business area within the cabinet to achieve more efficient operations within the department and improve services to constituents. This request will include the following changes:

A single appropriation bill to combine all positions into a single salary section for all divisions.

Combining Section 2 of Senate Bill 13 Act 119 of 2024 (Fund center Z50) and Section 4 of Senate Bill 13 Act 119 of 2024 (Fund center 224) operations appropriation sections, which are both funded by general revenue, to achieve flexibility.

Maintaining current existing and proposed special language, limited to the specific divisions identified in the language.

These changes will allow ADVA to efficiently utilize newly moved resources, both personnel and funding, needed to operate facilities which have a similar mission.
