


DHS SFY 2021 Budgeted Position Breakdown












Activity Reflected in the Budget

- Launch of Arkansas Integrated Eligibility System (ARIES)
- Development of Comprehensive Child Welfare Information System (CCWIS)
- Residential Option for Adolescents in Recovery (ROAR)
 - Intensive residential substance abuse treatment when a DYS commitment is not in the juvenile's best interest
- Continued focus on DYS community-based services
 - DYS shifted \$1.75 million from residential services to community-based services in SFY21
- Human development center staff restructuring
 - DDS will shift 1,244 positions to require CNA certification
 - DDS will also increase the RN to LPN ratio



Activity Reflected in the Budget

- Addition of 700 Slots to CES Waiver (often referred to as the "DD Waitlist")
- Physician Rate and Personal Care Rate increases
 - Ambulance
 - ADT / EIDT
 - DME Reduction to Medicare Cost
 - Pharmacy Administered Vaccines
- Additional Vaccine and Lab Cost for Covid-19
- Annual Rate Adjustments for Provider Groups
 - Nursing Home
 - Hospice
- Increases in Medicare Rates impacting supplemental costs and Medicaid cost sharing
- Renewal of Arkansas Works Waiver




Budget Risks

- Potential rise in the number of foster children in DHS custody
- Trend changes in the number of juveniles committed to DYS custody
- Economic conditions
- Litigation
 - ACA decision in *California v. Texas*
- Continuation of the federal COVID-19 Public Health Emergency
 - The state receives an enhanced FMAP during the PHE but is required to maintain Medicaid enrollment as well
- New biologics and other specialty drugs
- Arkansas Works Demonstration continuation




FMAP Assumptions






FMAP Assumptions With Enhanced FMAP During PHE






Enrollment Since Public Health Emergency Began
