**Executive Recommendation** 

Department of Education – New Special Language to amend Arkansas Code.

SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code § 6-51-303, concerning the administration of multidistrict vocational centers, is amended to read as follows:

(a) The management, maintenance, and operation of a center shall be the responsibility of the local school or institution approved by the State Board of Career Education to be the center.

(b) A center shall be administered in accordance with the guidelines and policies established by the board.

(c) If a county or school district enacted a local tax to fund the construction of the center, the county or school district may use vocational center aid funding for the management, maintenance and operation of the center.
