# <u>ORDER</u>

Now before the Arkansas State Claims Commission (the "Claims Commission") is the motion filed by the Arkansas Department of Transportation (the "Respondent") to dismiss the claim of Jerdnell Howard (the "Claimant"). Based upon a review of Respondent's motion, the arguments made therein, and the law of Arkansas, the Claims Commission hereby finds as follows:

- 1. Claimant filed the instant claim, alleging that Claimant's vehicle was damaged by a piece of plywood in the roadway.
- 2. Respondent filed a motion to dismiss pursuant to Rule 12(b)(6) of the Arkansas Rules of Civil Procedure, arguing that dismissal is appropriate because Claimant did not allege any negligence or wrongdoing on the part of Respondent.
  - 3. Claimant did not respond to the motion.
- 4. In reviewing this motion to dismiss, the Claims Commission must treat the facts alleged in the complaint as true and view them in a light most favorable to a claimant. *See Hodges v. Lamora*, 337 Ark. 470, 989 S.W.2d 530 (1999). All reasonable inferences must be resolved in favor of a claimant, and the complaint must be liberally construed. *See id.* However, a claimant must allege facts, not mere conclusions. *Dockery v. Morgan*, 2011 Ark. 94 at \*6, 380 S.W.3d 377, 382. The facts alleged in the complaint will be treated as true, but not "a plaintiff's theories, speculation, or statutory interpretation." *See id.* (citing *Hodges*, 337 Ark. 470, 989 S.W.2d 530 (1999)).

- 5. Claimant's claim is a negligence claim. The elements of a negligence claim are duty, breach of duty, and damages proximately caused by the breach. *See Chambers v. Stern*, 347 Ark. 395, 406, 64 S.W.3d 737, 744 (2002).
- 6. However, even applying the liberal *Hodges* standard, Claimant has not established any facts to show that Respondent breached its duty to maintain the state roadways. Even if there was a piece of plywood in the roadway, Claimant did not allege any facts to establish that that the plywood had been in the roadway for an extended period of time or that an employee of Respondent or a vehicle owned by Respondent was responsible for the plywood being in the roadway.
- 7. Respondent's motion is GRANTED, and Claimant's claim is DISMISSED without prejudice.

#### IT IS SO ORDERED.


