Dear Ms. Irby:

The State Treasurer's Office was notified November 2, 2022, that the *Twenty-Fourth Decennial Census of the United States* on file with the United States Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census, reflects a population count of 1,815 for the city of Calico Rock, Arkansas. This figure was incorporated November 10, 2022, into the formula used by the State Treasurer for calculation of General, Special, Highway Severance, Four Lane Highway Construction, and Wholesale Fuel Tax Revenues for the city of Calico Rock.

Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated §19-5-601(e), the State Treasurer has determined, based upon the corrected census count, the city of Calico Rock should have received \$13,788.21 additional General Revenues, \$45,125.65 additional Special Revenues, \$5,192.46 additional Highway Severance Revenues, \$28,215.69 additional Four Lane Highway Construction Revenues, and \$6,302.21 additional Wholesale Fuel Tax Revenues.
