- (1) Day habilitation providers of Early Intervention Day Treatment Services for children and Adult Development Day Treatment services;
 - (2) Personal care providers;
 - (3) ARChoices attendant care and respite care providers; and
 - (4) Outpatient substance abuse providers.

Additionally, Community and Employment Supports Waiver providers for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities shall be allowed to increase waiver plans to reflect mandated increases in the minimum wage for direct care workers. The Department shall also direct its actuary to recalculate the Provider-Led Arkansas Shared Savings Entity (PASSE) capitation rates for 2019 to include all these rate increases and shall pay the PASSE capitation rates reflective of the recalculated increases.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.
