SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>ASU</u> <u>SYSTEM SHARED SERVICES REALLOCATIONS. Upon determination by the President of</u> <u>the ASU System that a reallocation of resources for purposes of</u> <u>reorganization or consolidation of administrative functions within the System</u> <u>is necessary for efficient and effective operations of the System, the</u> <u>President, with approval of the board of trustees, may have the authority to</u> <u>transfer positions, appropriations and related funds between campuses,</u> <u>divisions, branches, and other budgetary units of the System, after receiving</u> <u>prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. The</u> <u>transfers of positions, programs, or activities shall be used for those</u> <u>purposes for which the appropriations were approved by the General Assembly.</u> <u>The transfers, consolidations, or reorganizations which involve academic</u> <u>programs shall be reviewed by the Division of Higher Education as applicable.</u> No Tobacco Settlement funds or appropriations may be reallocated pursuant to this section.

Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general revenue funding for institutions of higher education each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for institutions of higher education and the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that institutions of higher education may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to institutions of higher education authorizing broad powers under this section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026.
