BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - SAVE THE CHILDREN. There is hereby  
appropriated, to the Department of Education, to be payable from the Division  
of Elementary and Secondary Education Fund Account, the following:

(A) for a grant for statewide after school literacy, nutrition, home  
visiting and early childhood programs to be administered by Save the Children  
for low income, at-risk children of the Department of Education - Division of  
Elementary and Secondary Education - Save the Children, in a sum not to  
exceed .....\$500,000.

SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
