Please AMEND the following:

SECTION 2.- APPROPRIATION- STATE OPERATIONS, please add \$2,908,907.00 in appropriation to item (06) INDUSTRY TRAINING PROGRAM.

Please ADD the following:

SECTION SPECIAL LANGUAGE, NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW, ADDITIONAL PAYMENTS AUTHORIZED. The Arkansas Industrial and Economic Development Foundation is hereby authorized to make additional payments to the Director of the Arkansas Economic Development Commission, from private funding sources, and upon prior approval from the Economic Development Commission, the Arkansas Industrial and Economic Development Foundation, and the Governor. Such additional payments to the Director of the Arkansas Economic Development Commission shall not be considered salary and shall not be deemed or construed to exceed the maximum salaries established for unclassified employees by the General Assembly. Nothing in this section may be constructed to reduce or eliminate the authority granted elsewhere in the Arkansas statues for the payment of allowances or bonuses to unclassified employees.
