SAS PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING TRANSFER. Department of Finance and Administration - Building Authority Division may from time to time as may be necessary and in such amounts as may be necessary and with the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, request a transfer of funds from the Insurance Department Trust Fund to the Building Authority Division Real Estate Fund to provide funds for land acquisition and building construction in an amount not to exceed two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000). Upon his approval, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall then initiate the necessary transfer documents to reflect the transfer upon the fiscal records of the State Auditor, the State Treasurer, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and Department of Finance and Administration - Building Authority Division. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015

through June 30, 2016.

SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

1 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
2 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly that the effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Fiscal Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.

(1) A growing number of regional solid waste management districts within the state are facing difficulty in funding the necessary costs of closure and post-closure care of landfills owned by the districts; and

(2) Without closure and post-closure care of landfills, irreparable harm to human health and the environment will occur.

- (b) Notwithstanding <u>Arkansas Code</u> § 8-6-1001 et seq. and <u>Acts 2013</u>, No. 1202, § 41 any Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund cleanup restrictions enumerated in this Act, the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality also may:
- (1) Expend monies from the Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund to a state-approved contractor or the regional solid waste management district to complete all actions necessary to achieve the final closure and post-closure care of a landfill owned by a regional solid waste management district if the department determines that the regional solid waste management district:

(A) Has filed for protection under federal bankruptcy law;

(B) Is unable to meet its debt obligations in the ordinary

course

of its operations; or

(C) Is otherwise insolvent; and

(2) Institute a civil action against the regional solid waste management district and all of the entities composing the regional solid waste management district to seek the recovery of any funds expended from the Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund under subdivision (b)(1) of this section, unless satisfactory repayment arrangements are reached and agreed upon by the department with the district and the bondholders.

(c) This section is in effect only from July 1, 2014, through June 30,

2017.

This request makes technical corrections to the existing special language in the bill.

Please insert the following as Section 45 and renumber accordingly:

SECTION 45. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SUSPENSION OF LANDFILL DISPOSAL FEES TO SUPPORT A COMPUTER AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT RECYCLING PROGRAM.

(a) The landfill disposal fee to support a computer and electronic equipment recycling program levied under Arkansas Code § 8-6-612(a) shall not be levied from the effective date of this act through June 30, 2017.

(b) Any landfill disposal fees collected under Arkansas Code § 8-6-

612(a) before the effective date of this act shall be:

(1) Collected as provided under Arkansas Code § 8-6-612(c); and

(2) Distributed as provided under Arkansas Code § 8-6-616 and

this Act.

This request will suspend a landfill disposal fee that will be replaced by a separate fee in the future. This proposed language allows the distribution of revenues already collected.
