Provided, however, that institutions and agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

If the Public Defender Commission should determine that the appropriations made available for payments to the Counties are insufficient, appropriation may be transferred from the Public Defender Commission Program line item to the Bail Bond-County Public Defender line item, after receiving approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016 2017 through June 30, 2017 2018.

SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MATCHING FUNDS. The funds appropriated in this Act for Department of Justice Non-Victim Assistance Matching Grants shall be used for matching funds for administering the Federal Grants provided in this Act for the Department of Justice Non-Victim Assistance Grants. The Department of Finance and Administration - Management Services Division is hereby authorized to call upon all state agencies to assist in the implementation of the Department of Justice Non-Victim Assistance Grants. The funds appropriated in this Act for Department of Justice Non-Victim Assistance Matching Grants shall be used to provide one hundred percent (100%) of the required matching funds for state agencies and to provide up to sixty percent (60%) of the required matching funds for local governments. Such funds and appropriation shall be transferred to eligible state agencies or paid to local governments to be used for matching federal funds for administration of the Department of Justice Non-Victim Assistance Grants in such amounts as determined by the Arkansas Alcohol and Drug Abuse Coordinating Council or other oversight agency as designated by the Governor. Any unobligated balances in funds in this Act for the Department of Justice Non-Victim Assistance Grants may be used by state agencies as matching funds for other U.S. Department of Justice Grants in an amount determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Any unexpended balances in funds provided for Department of Justice Non-Victim Assistance Matching Grants in this act remaining on June 30, 2016 2017, may be carried forward and used for the same purpose during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 2018.
