AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2011-2012 FISCAL YEAR.

Amendment No. to House Bill No. 1310

Amend House Bill No. 1310 as engrossed, H3/7/11 (version: 03 07/2011 04:05:50 PM)

Insert an additional SECTION immediately following SECTION 80 to read as follows:

SECTION 80. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING -GRANTS TO FIRE DEPARTMENTS. After funds collected pursuant to §26-57-614 are distributed in accordance with §14-284-403, any remaining balance of authorized funding for grants to fire departments for Crittenden County during the 2010-2011 fiscal year in the amount of one hundred fifty-three thousand eight hundred and ninety-four dollars (\$153,894) or above, shall be distributed as follows: (a) sixteen percent (16%) shall be distributed to the Edmonson Fire Department up to a maximum of twenty-four thousand five hundred thirty two dollars (\$24,532), and (b) thirty-two percent (32%) shall be distributed to the Earle Fire Department up to a maximum of forty-nine thousand seventy dollars (\$49,070), (c) fifty-two percent (52%) shall be distributed to the Marion Fire Department up to a maximum of eighty thousand two hundred ninety-two dollars (\$80,292). Any balances remaining for Crittenden County following the distribution in subsections (a) through (c) of this Section, shall be distributed to active fire departments based on population."

AND

Delete SECTION 82 in its entirety and substitute the following"

" SECTION 82. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011, with the exception that Section 80

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in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval, is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011, with the exception that Section 80 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval, could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011, with the exception that Section 80 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval."

Page 4. immediately following Section 5 insert a new section to read as follows:

"SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>FUND</u> <u>TRANSFER PROVISION. Immediately upon the effective date of this act, the</u> <u>Commissioner of State Lands shall deposit from unobligated cash funds, the</u> <u>amount of seven million six hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$7,650,000) into</u> the State Treasury. Upon receipt thereof, the Treasurer of State shall credit to each of the following fund or fund accounts the amounts listed below:

a) the sum of four million dollars (\$4,000,000) to be deposited into the General Revenue Fund Account of the State Apportionment Fund to be distributed as all other General Revenue to replace revenues from the adoption of HB1.18 of 2011,

b) the sum of two million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$2,700,000) to the Mid-South Community College Fund for the allocations to the Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium (ADTEC) Partners and University Center Fartners for personal services, operating expenses, equipment and grants as appropriated in HB1357 of 2011,

c) the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to the Department of Education Public School Fund Account for the Public School Athletic Trainer Pilot Program grants for personal services to provide access to athletic trainers in public school and to promote the health and safety of students as appropriated in SB211 of 2011,

d) the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to the Mid-South Community College Fund for personal services and operating expenses, construction, inprovements, equipment, renovation, and maintenance expenses of the Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium as appropriated in SB573 of 2011,

e) the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to the Arkansas State University Fund for personal services and operating expenses, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and maintenance expenses

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of the Arkansas State University - Heritage Sites, including the Hemingway-Pfeifer House, Tenant Farmers Museum, and Lakeport Plantation as appropriated in SB056 of 2011,

<u>f)</u> the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to the University of Arkansas at Little Rock Fund for personal services and operating expenses, research, and development of viable technologies of the University of Arkansas at Little Rock - Nanotechnology Center as appropriated in SB575 of 2011, and

g) the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences for the Arkansas Commission on Child Abuse, Rape and Domestic Violence."

(11) Participate or seek to participate in Social Security Act Section 1115(a)(1) waiver authority that would allow operation of a demonstration project or program;

(12) Participate or seek to participate in a Social Security Act Section 1115(a)(2) request for the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services to provide federal financial participation for costs associated with a demonstration project or program;

(13) Implement managed care provisions under Section 1932 of Medicaid, Title XIX of the Social Security Act; or

(14) Participate or seek to participate in the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services Innovation projects or programs."

There is hereby established a new program</u> for the comprehensive care of Adult Sickle Cell Disease to be known as the <u>University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences Adult Sickle Cell Disease</u> <u>Program. Amend House Bill No. 1263 as originally introduced:

Immediately following SECTION 31 of the bill, insert the following: "SECTION 32. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>BREAST</u> CARE PROGRAM. The Arkansas Department of Health shall annually budget, allocate, and expend for the Breast Care Program as appropriated in Section 5, the sum of at least four million seven hundred fifty-five thousand dollars (\$4,755,000) for Breast Cancer screening, diagnosis, treatment and outreach expenses of the Breast Care Program.

The Arkansas Department of Health shall file an annual progress report by each January 1 preceding a session of the General Assembly to the Co-Chairs of the Legislative Women's Caucus. This report shall include amounts budgeted, allocated and expended for the Breast Care Program for testing, diagnosis, treatment and outreach expenses.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012."
